

Email may be useful for such things as scheduling appointments, providing updates in between sessions, or asking questions that may call for a fairly brief answer. When Dr. King is serving in a court-ordered role, use of email may be a routine method of communication.

When you send Dr. King an email and expect a reply from her via email you are taking certain risks. Other persons such as systems managers, family members, or other unknown persons may read the email communications despite efforts to prevent this. There is also the risk that either you or Dr. King could inadvertently send an email to unintended recipients.

For these reasons, you are advised to use a private email account and not a work-related email account for communications with Dr. King. If you will be using email communication with Dr. King routinely, you are advised to set up a separate account for this purpose only. You are also advised to password protect the email account you use for these communications.
